



2010 RIO VISTA WINTER SCHOOLING SHOW

Entry Fees: \$15.00 per class. Pre-registration (which is greatly appreciated) requires no prepayment. Entries should be mailed to Rio Vista Farm, 13013 Fallwell Lane, Del Valle, Texas 78617, or called or faxed to (512) 247-2303. Entries close at 9:00pm on the Thursday before the show date. Entries received after 9:00pm on Thursday before the show date will be charged a \$25 late fee. There will be a \$30 Ambulance fee charged for each rider entered.

Prizes: Trophy and six ribbons will be awarded in all classes (except leadline). Championship trophy and ribbon and reserve ribbon will be awarded in each division in accordance with AHSA Rule XXIV, Chapter VII. All ribbons and prizes must be picked up by the end of the show on the day of the show. No prizes/ribbons will be saved or mailed. Please ask a friend to claim them for you if you are unable to stay.

Attire: Appropriate attire required. Coats optional. ALL riders must wear approved hard hats while mounted. This includes any area on the grounds. Numbers must be worn and be clearly visible.

Weather changes: ALL show date changes due to weather will be noted on the outgoing message at 247-2303. If the outgoing message makes no mention of cancellation or postponement then the show is being held as scheduled.
