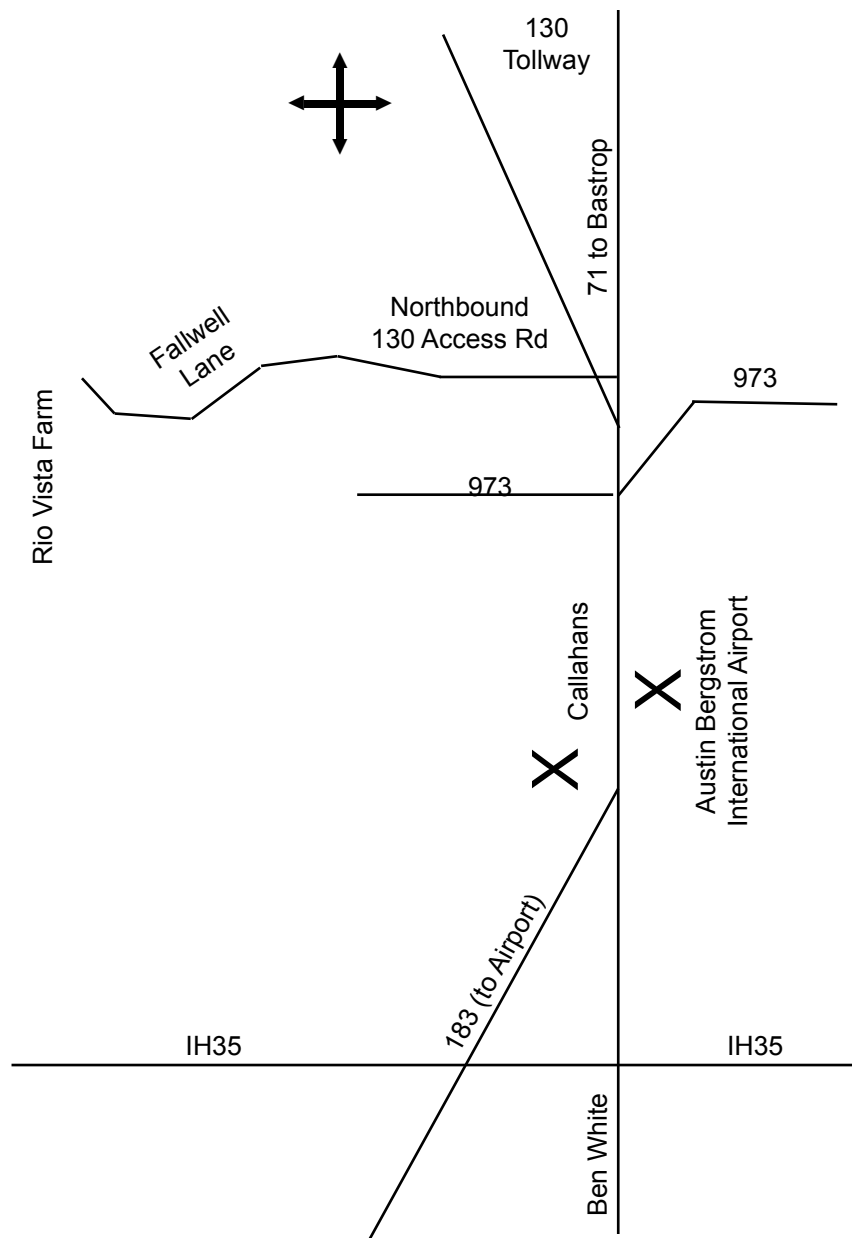
MEMBERSHIP REQUIREMENTS: All exhibitors must be members of the Texas Schooling Show Association. Memberships are \$15.00 for individuals and \$20.00 for families and may be paid at the show or sent to Susan McMorris, 1000 Fallwell Lane, Del Valle, TX 78617.

PRIZES: Trophy and six ribbons will be awarded in all classes (except Leadline). Championship trophy and ribbon and reserve ribbon will be awarded in each division in accordance with AHSA Rule XXIV, Chapter VII. All ribbons and prizes must be picked up by the end of the show on the day of the show. No prizes/ribbons will be saved or mailed. Please ask a friend to claim them for you if you are unable to stay.

ATTIRE: Appropriate attire required. Coats optional. Approved hard hats must be worn by ALL riders while mounted. This includes any area on the grounds. Numbers must be worn and be clearly visible.

WEATHER CHANGES: All show date changes due to weather will be noted on the outgoing message at 512-247-2303. If the outgoing message makes no mention of cancellation or postponement then the show is being held as scheduled.

- Traveling East on Hwy 71 - go approx. 1 mile past the Austin Airport - stay on the 71 access road to the right
- Go past the entrance to 130 - Turn left onto the 130 access road at the second light past the 130 entrance- Follow the 130 access road straight ahead until it dead ends into Falwell Lane- Turn right onto Fallwell

TSSA Points Fences 18"

Open to all beginners. The course may be trotted or cantered. A horse may be used by more than one rider and each rider may receive championship points and year-end points. RIDERS MAY ONLY CROSS ENTER INTO 2' VERTICAL HUNTER OR 2' VERTICAL EQUITATION DIVISIONS.

TSSA Points Fences 2'

Open to all beginners . The course will be made up of simple fences, without a change of direction. Riders in this division who are not entered in any cross rail hunter or cross rail equitation classes may cross enter only into the 2' Hunter and 2' Equitation divisions.
